

## Important Information for Prospective Students

- Application requirements are the same for E-campus as for on-campus students and consist of the following:
  - Current GRE scores (less than 5 years old)
  - Current TOEFL scores ( less than 2 years old, if applicable)
  - Three professional letters of reference
  - One official transcript from each college/university ever attended
  - Statement of objectives
- The program can be completed in a minimum of 2 years and no more than 7 years. Typically, students complete the program in 3 – 4 years.
- Students are admitted in Fall term only.
- Master of Health Physics students are required to take a comprehensive oral exam.
- Masters of Sciences students are required to complete a [thesis and thesis defense](#).
- Travel to campus is required for:
  - Two one-week, on-campus summer laboratory classes. They may be taken in the same summer or not.
  - Each student must be present on campus for their thesis defense or comprehensive oral exam at the end of their program.
- Prospective students are advised to consult the NERHP Graduate Student [Handbook](#) and the “Policies Covering all Graduate Students” contained in the OSU online [General Catalog and Schedule of Classes](#) for additional and specific requirements.
- Department funding is not available for E-campus students. Federal student loans and scholarships through Extended Campus are available for students who qualify.
